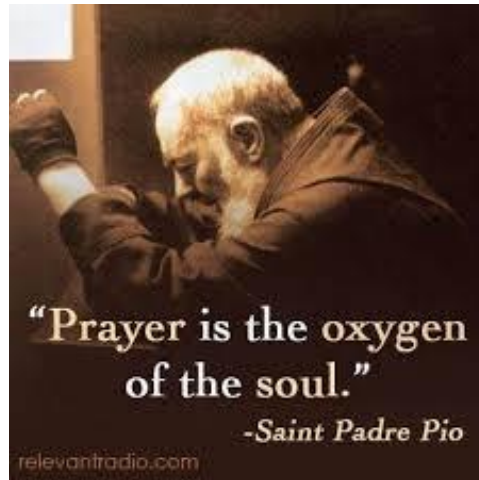


St James Supports the Homecoming Parade

As you know, in the past St. James has participated in Samaritan's Purse Operation Christmas Child (shoeboxes). This year we have decided to focus on online shoeboxes, where for \$25 you can send a shoebox to a child in an underserved country. You can choose items from three categories to fill it, or they can choose for you. However, if you want to fill a physical shoebox with a grandchild, niece/nephew or neighbor (or yourself), there are boxes available as well as items the mission committee has in reserve. They will be available on the black table in the Undercroft the end of October. In the summer there was a father from Prattsburgh who was in a bad accident, and the mission committee donated \$500 to help as he was the sole support of his family. We are happy to report that he is doing well and will be able to return to work next month!
